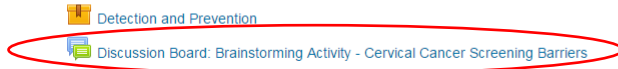

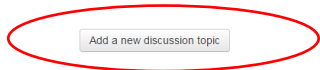

(time length: 10 minutes) After posting your responses, please read your classmates' responses and provide positive comments to at least two of your classmates' responses to the discussion.



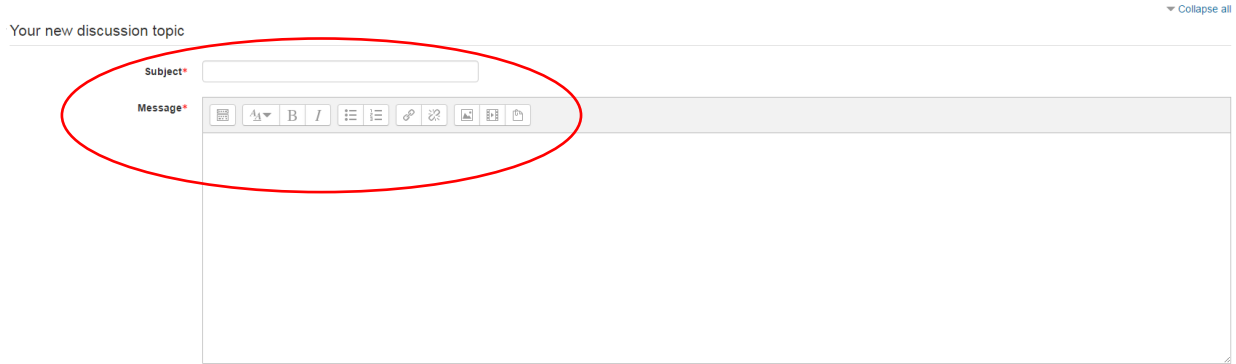
